

Single/Multi-Layer Animation at Bhoonidhi Vista

To enable multi-layer visualization and animation, Vista employs a 2-step method for creating animation.

1. Layer Selection
2. Date Range Selection & Animation

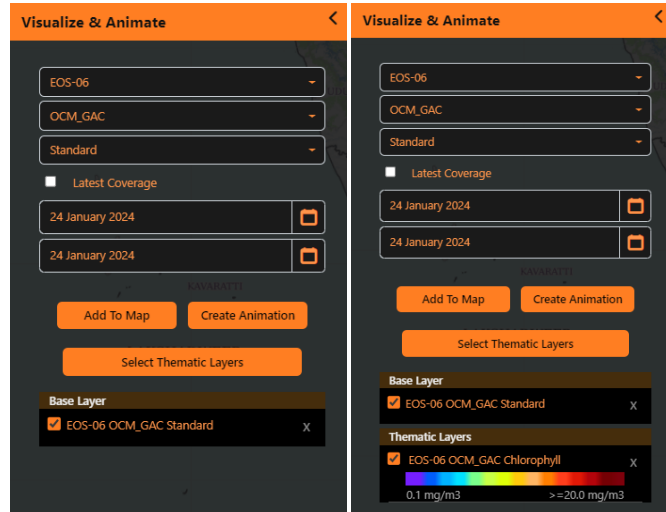
I. Layer Selection:

A. Single Layer Animation:

1. In 'Visualize and Animate' > select satellite-sensor-product (Selection of dates is not necessary).
2. Click 'Add to Map'

B. Multi-Layer Animation:

1. In 'Visualize and Animate' > select satellite-sensor-product (Selection of dates is not necessary).
2. Click 'Add to Map'
3. Click 'Select Thematic Layers'
4. Add the preferred thematic layers from the popup and close the popup.

5. Tick the checkbox of required thematic layer to add them to map

II. Date Range Selection & Animation:

1. Once the layer(s) for animation are added, proceed to the following steps to create animation.
2. Mark your Area of Interest (AOI) for animation using the icon  to draw a rectangle and icon  to mark a point.



3. After marking the AOI, click 'Create Animation'.
4. Update the time interval according to preferred speed of animation.
5. Modify the date range for animation. (Note: The date range selected must be at least the length of 2 revisit cycles for the selected dataset)
6. Click 'Start Animation'
